Auto Dismantling Program Subjectivities

Yard Control Requirements

Customers that are allowed to "pick their own parts" must have documentation that will include confirmation of:

- Customers will be charged a fee and must sign a waiver holding insured harmless prior to entering the yard. Copy of waiver required with bind request.
- Customers under the age of 18 years old must be accompanied by a legal guardian to enter the vard
- All fluids must be drained from all autos prior to vehicle entering the yard area
- Spare jacks must be removed from trunks of dismantled cars prior to being placed in yard
- Vehicles in customer accessible area will not be stacked
- full service yard must be separated and fenced from the self-service yard
- Any vehicle waiting for processing must be kept away from self-service area; including vehicles
 waiting to be crushed & prepped prior to entering the self-service area. This area must be
 fenced & separated from the self-service area
- Customers are no allowed to bring jacks or heavy tools into yard
- Customer tool boxes are checked prior to entering the yard & exiting the yard
- Tools will not be loaned by the insured to the customer
- Employees must be located in yard at all times overseeing removal of parts
- Cars must be secure & have enough space between the autos next to them.
- Customers are not allowed under the vehicles
- Customers are not allowed to remove large or heavy parts; these must be removed by yard supervisor and delivered to the customers vehicle
- Walkways must be maintained with no protruding objects & unobstructed. Yard must be free from trip & fall exposures & maintained in a "nonskid" condition
- Exits signs must be posted & property identified

Prohibited Exposures

- Transformer dismantling
- Risks involving brake repair using salvage/used parts
- Risks involved in the rental and leasing of vehicles or mobile equipment
- Risks involved in the dismantling/sales of farm or industrial equipment
- Any repackaging of parts under insured's own name/label
- Any warranty, guarantee or certification of parts
- Any exposures involving hauling for others (towing or trucking)
- Guard dogs
